Details

The THYME Project provides support for academics and knowledge exchange staff from one of the THYME universities (York, Teesside and Hull) to spend time working with staff from another or from a company. The aim is to exchange knowledge, share best practice, drive collaboration and improve understanding of the relative capabilities of the THYME organisations.

This funding covers travel and subsistence for placements between the partners, up to a maximum of £1k per placement.

At the end of the placement a final report will be required, outlining the placement details, and the lessons learnt and placement outcomes.

Examples of possible placements

The scheme is highly flexible and placements may involve a single visit or several visits over a period of up to 6 months: for example, 1-2 days per week over a period of months; a dedicated fortnight's work to achieve a specific project; or a 3-6 month secondment.

Examples of possible placements include:

- a temporary job swap between university business development managers to share best practice and exchange contacts
- shadowing of an individual academic to learn useful techniques or acquire new skills
- developing a research collaboration between THYME universities
- putting together a bid for the THYME proof-of-concept funding scheme
- a series of visits to develop industry-academia relations
